CAPTION: Umatilla County Second Amendment Preservation Ordinance

QUESTION: Shall Umatilla County voters adopt the Second Amendment Preservation Ordinance?

EXPLANATION: A "yes" vote adopts and makes part of the Umatilla County Code the Second Amendment Preservation Ordinance. If approved the ordinance requires:

- Any law or regulation in violation of the US or Oregon Constitution pertaining to the right to bear arms to be deemed as unconstitutional and void;
- Prohibits the use of Umatilla County funds, facilities, employees and other Umatilla County Government resources for the purpose of enforcing any law or regulation deemed in violation of the US or Oregon Constitution pertaining to the right to bear arms.
- It shall be the duty of the Sheriff to determine whether any law or regulation pertaining to the right to bear arms violates the US or Oregon Constitution.
- A violation of the Umatilla County Second Amendment Ordinance would be punishable by a maximum fine of \$2,000.00 for an individual, or \$4,000.00 for a corporation.
- The Ordinance would be effective immediately upon certification of approval by the voters of Umatilla County.
