

MARINERS: Gordon’s only other homer of season was on April 1

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his longest outing since June 16, 2015.

Nick Martini had three hits for the A’s and Matt Olson added two. Oakland entered the day one game behind first-place Houston.

“In games like that, typically what happens, it’s one pitch,” A’s manager Bob Melvin said. “That was the case today. Even though today was tough, we have to look at it as a positive. We took the series.”

Both teams squandered numerous scoring opportunities before Seattle scraped together two runs on one hit.

After Petit (5-3) got lead-off man Denard Span to

ground out, Mike Zunino walked. Gordon hit the next pitch over the right-field wall. Then he flexed and kissed his biceps.

“I was messing with Cam (Maybin) and (Denard Span) because they’ve been calling me skinny so I had to let them know I’ve got some guns,” Gordon said. “And it was a big situation ... in a playoff race. Just having fun.”

Gordon’s only other home run was a solo shot against Cleveland on April 1 in Seattle’s third game of the season.

James Pazos (3-1) retired one batter for the victory. Edwin Diaz pitched the 12th for his major league-leading

47th save in 50 opportunities.

The Mariners had two on with one out in the ninth and

on in the 11th before Pazos got Khris Davis to strike out swinging.

Olson singled leading off the 12th before Diaz struck out Stephen Piscotty, Marcus Semien and pinch-hitter Chad Pinder.

CLOSING IN ON A RECORD

Diaz converted all six save opportunities on the Mariners’ road trip and is one shy of the franchise record of 48 set by Fernando Rodney in 2014. Rodney is with the A’s in a setup role.

THIS AND THAT

Segura leads the majors with 18 three-hit games. ... A’s third baseman Matt Chapman doubled in the sixth to extend his hitting

streak to a career-best 13 games. Chapman has also reached safely in 29 straight, the longest active streak in the AL.

UP NEXT

Mariners: LHP Wade LeBlanc (7-2, 3.80 ERA) pitches against the Dodgers on Friday in Seattle to begin a six-game homestand. LeBlanc is 1-7 in 11 career appearances against Los Angeles.

Athletics: RHP Edwin Jackson (4-2, 2.48) faces the Houston Astros on Friday. Jackson’s ERA is the fourth-lowest in the American League since he joined Oakland on June 25.

BOISE: QB Brett Rypien voted MWC preseason player of the year

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in 2011. His squad was picked to finish runner-up in the West.

“When (the Mountain West) started I don’t think anybody thought it would be what it is right now,” Long said. “I think that the caliber of football we play, the caliber of coaches in the league is better and better and better every single year.

Things to know as the Mountain West heads into season No. 20:

PRESEASON AWARDS: Rypien was voted the conference’s preseason player of the year. He’s thrown for 9,876 yards and 60 TDs over 37 games.

Wyoming senior defensive back Andrew Wingard earned

the preseason defensive player of the year nod for a second straight season. Wingard has 367 career tackles and is 88 tackles short of breaking the Mountain West record held by New Mexico’s Carmen Messina (2008-11).

On special teams, Boise State sophomore Avery Williams earned the player of the year nod. He had two punt returns for scores in 2017.

EXPOSURE: The Mountain West has frequently been late-night viewing, with kick-offs after 10 p.m. on the East Coast. It’s the price of being on television, even if it’s not the ideal slot.

Given a choice, Harsin would pick a more favorable time.

“Noon. Saturday. Consistently,” Harsin said. “Be able to go home and watch the other

guys go through the misery at the end of the night.”

FACEBOOK FRIENDS: The league will have seven games air on Facebook this season, beginning with two on Sept. 1 — Stony Brook at Air Force, followed by Idaho at Fresno State. Last season, six Mountain West games were on Facebook and reached more than 17 million fans, with the Utah State at Wyoming

game on Oct. 14 reaching 4.6 million.
