Pursuant to the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) and the National Historic Preservation Act (NHPA), EDA is conducting an assessment of the potential of the proposed project to affect the environment and/or historic properties. The project will support the growth of the Pendleton Unmanned Aerial System (UAS) Test Range. The test range serves as critical infrastructure in the UAS ecosystem nationwide and internationally. The Pendleton UAS Test Range is a campus where the new UAS technology is researched, designed and tested before the technology can be commercialized. By assisting the FAA with the safe integration of the National Airspace System, the Pendleton UAS Test Range essentially acts as a "bridge to market" for new technology.
