The fate of nearly 300 spring chinook salmon may be resolved today as meetings continue between Indian leaders from the Umatilla and Nez Perce reservations and state and federal officials in Portland. The adult salmon — hatchery fish that have returned to the Imnaha River on the eastern edge of Oregon — will be killed under the Oregon Wild Fish Policy, which restricts the number of hatchery fish allowed to spawn naturally to protect the genetic integrity of wild fish. The state wild fish policy allows for no more than 50 percent of the fish passed for natural spawning above the Imnaha weir near Gumboot Creek to be of hatchery origin. Tribal fisheries experts prefer out-planting the extra fish to spawn naturally in tributaries of the Imnaha.
