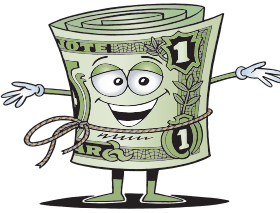

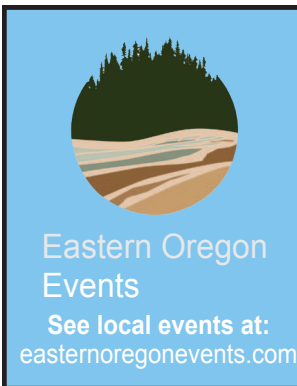

The draft decision notice and finding of no significant impact (DN/FONSI) and environmental assessment (EA) for the Umatilla National Forest Forestwide Aquatic Restoration project are now available for public review and comment. The project is intended to restore riparian function and improve conditions for the recovery of aquatic species. Projects would occur in streams and riparian areas within the Umatilla National Forest administrative boundaries and adjacent lands. The Washington counties in the planning area include Asotin, Columbia, Garfield and Walla Walla, and Oregon counties include Baker, Grant, Morrow, Umatilla, Union, Wallowa and Wheeler. This proposed decision is subject to objection pursuant to 36 CFR 218, Subparts A and B. Objections will only be accepted from those who submitted project-specific written comments during scoping or other designated comment period. Issues raised in objections must be based on previously submitted comments unless based on new information arising after the designated comment period(s).

Objections must be submitted within 45 days of the publication of this legal notice. The date of this legal notice is the exclusive means for calculating the time to file an objection.
