Burt Reynolds, star of film, TV and tabloids

Burt Reynolds, the handsome film and television star known for his acclaimed performances in "Deliverance" and "Boogie Nights," commercial hits such as "Smokey and the Bandit" and for an active off-

screen love life which included relationships with Loni Anderson and Sally Field, has died at age 82.

In a statement, his niece, Nancy Lee Hess, called his death Thursday "totally unexpected," although she acknowledged he had health issues.

"He was tough. Anyone who

breaks their tail bone on a river and finishes the movie is tough. And that's who he was."

Hess noted her uncle's kindness and generosity, and thanked "all of his amazing fans who have always supported and cheered him on, through all of the hills and valleys of his life and career."
