YOU ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED of a Public Meeting to be held before the Umatilla County Planning Commission on **Thursday, October 25, 2018 at 6:30 p.m.** at the Stafford Hansell Government Center, 915 SE Columbia Drive, Hermiston, OR. The meeting will consist of a work session between the Planning Commission and the Technical Advisory Committee for the Highway 395 North Development Code Project.

The purpose of the Umatilla County U.S. Highway 395 North Development Code project is to create standards for the U.S. Highway 395 North corridor between the cities of Umatilla and Hermiston to implement previous planning and studies, improve the corridor's aesthetics and function, improve multi-modal connectivity and transportation options within the corridor and between the cities of Hermiston and Umatilla, and provide safe access for all modes of transportation, including non-motorized transportation (e.g., pedestrians and cyclists).
