After they retired from farming they enjoyed traveling the U.S. in their RV. Even after Paul passed in 1989, Belva and her girlfriends traveled the U.S. including Hawaii. Belva and her dear friends enjoyed baseball and basketball on TV. She lamented that she was disappointed that after 20 years of enjoying and cheering the Seattle Mariners baseball team, they still can't make the playoffs!

Belva's husband, Paul, and daughter, Doreen, preceded Belva in death.
