Easter Carrot Cake

- Ingredients**
- 2 1/2 cups all-purpose flour
 - 12 ounces grated carrots
 - 1 teaspoon baking powder
 - 1 teaspoon baking soda
 - 1/4 teaspoon ground cinnamon
 - 1/2 teaspoon salt
 - 10 ounces sugar
 - 1/4 cup dark brown sugar
 - 3 large eggs
 - 6 ounces plain yogurt
 - 6 ounces vegetable oil

- Directions**
1. Preheat oven to 350 degrees Fahrenheit.
 2. Butter and flour a 9-inch cake pan.
 3. Put carrots into a large mixing bowl.
 4. Process flour, baking powder, baking soda, spices and salt for 5 seconds in food processor; add this mixture to the carrots.
 5. In the bowl of the food processor, combine the sugar, brown sugar, eggs, yogurt and vegetable oil; pour this mixture into the carrots and stir until combined. Pour into the prepared cake pan and bake for 45 minutes.

- CREAM CHEESE FROSTING**
- 8 ounces cream cheese
 - 2 ounces unsalted butter
 - 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
 - 9 ounces powdered sugar

Directions
Combine the cream cheese and butter. Add vanilla and powdered sugar gradually until smooth. Refrigerate until ready and top the cake.



Dyeing Easter Eggs Naturally!

Start by buying white eggs from your local grocer or farmer's market. The white color allows colors to shine through. You can mix in some brown eggs on which to start with a darker base color, if you prefer. Once you choose, hard-boil and cool your eggs, it's time to get color-ful.

A MESS IS OK

The key to a fun egg-coloring experience is giving the kiddos plenty of room to experiment with colors and design techniques. Clear the area and lay out all the necessary materials ahead of time. Don't forget the newspaper barrier between the dyes and your counter-top (especially if you've got a countertop with a porous surface). The more prep work you can do beforehand, the more you'll be able to actually enjoy coloring eggs.

NATURAL INGREDIENTS

Working with natural dyes is the best way to go this Easter. Try using ingredients such as blueberries or powdered drink mix to dye your eggs. Vegetables offer great materials for color. Try spinach, red cabbage, beets and dill seeds. These ingredients are easy to find and will let you stay as natural while also saving some money along the way.

GET FANCY

If you have any fans of glitter in your home, there is a glamorous way to decorate eggs that might be right up their alley. A bit of glue and colorful glitter are all you need to create over-the-top Easter eggs. You can find glitter in a variety of sizes and colors, or go with sequins instead, for a pop of stunning color.

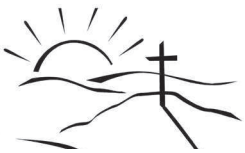
