### STATEMENT OF CHANGES IN ACTIVITIES and SOURCES OF FINANCING \*

Marina Fund: This fund was abolished by Resolution No. 19-02 on April 9, 2019. Container Dock Fund: Container business on river barges through the Port of Umatilla is non-existent. Handling log exports has decreased significantly while refrigerated container activity is thriving at the Port of Umatilla. Regional Water: At the end of FY 2019-2020 the working capital balance will be transferred in full to the General Fund and the fund will be closed by Resolution. Grants and Appropriations Fund: In a previous legislation we were awarded \$2 million for a Road Project. We anticipate receiving the appropriation for the FY 2019-2020. Water Rights Fund: The total in this fund will be transferred to the General Fund and then will be abolished by Resolution in the fall of 2019.
