“They’ve talked to me every year since I was a freshman,” he said. “I feel like (Pendleton) has the best coaches in the state, really. They pushed us every day.”

Camp, a La Grande resident and the son of the Mountaineers’ coach Camp, was introduced to football by his father at an early age. Although he is undecided on his major, it was the appeal of hitting the gridiron for a program like Eastern that drew him to the school.

“It’s a great program and a great school,” he said. “I want to be a great

teammate and a leader. (Pendleton) accepted me from the very start. They made me a part of the team right away.”

Coach Camp said he intends to keep the Pendleton trio in their respective positions they held as Buckaroos. The Mountaineers went 4-7 overall last season.

“(Eastern) has three huge pillars with this group,” Pendleton head coach Erik Davis told a crowded room full of family and friends. “It’s easy to see why (Pendleton has) been successful. We’ve built a program of high-character and hard-working kids like this.”

my wife, she is in love with the community, the city and the club,” Valeri said. “We are very happy about it.”

General manager Gavin Wilkinson hinted at the rumored contentious nature of the negotiations but noted that in the end, bringing Valeri back was important to the Timbers.

“Obviously getting Valeri sorted was, from the start of last year actually, a key objective. The unfortunate part is it took so long for all parties to come back to where we knew we needed to be,” Wilkinson said at the team’s recent media day. “From a club perspective and from a fan perspective, we’re all delighted that he’s back. What he has done for this club, and what he will con-

tinue to do, is remarkable.”

Valeri is about to embark on his eighth season with Portland and joined the Timbers as they headed to Costa Rica for a two-week training camp.

Valeri came to the Timbers in 2013 from Lanus, a top-division team in his native Argentina. He went on to become Portland’s all-time leader in MLS goals (76) and assists (81).

In 2015, he scored a goal 27 seconds into the MLS Cup final and the Timbers went on to win the title with a 2-1 victory over the Columbus Crew. He was named the match’s MVP.

Two years later, he won the league’s MVP award after wrapping up the season with 21 goals and 11 assists. It was the first time in MLS history that a midfielder topped 20 goals in a season.

BMCC suffers conference losses to Treasure Valley

ONTARIO — The Blue Mountain women’s basketball team stayed winless in Northwest Athletic Conference play as they suffered a 76-56 road loss to Treasure Valley on Wednesday night.

The Timberwolves were held to just nine points in the first quarter as the Chukars poured in 16 points to take control early. Blue Mountain’s offense came out of the half ready to compete, falling just 23-18 and 22-18 in quarters three and four

respectively, but could not overcome their early deficit.

Madi McKrola led Blue Mountain (2-18, 0-9) with 12 points on the night, and chipped in six rebounds. Hailey Miller followed with 11 points. Alyia Munoz grabbed a team-high eight rebounds and six steals. Brooke Wheeler finished with nine points — just one shy of 500 career points.

Lilly Kelly led Treasure Valley with a game-high 26 points, and added 10 rebounds and an 11-of-13 performance at the line. Sammi Jessop had 21

rebounds — 11 offensive and 10 defensive — for the Chukars.

Blue Mountain returns home for an NWAC contest against Columbia Basin on Saturday. Game time is at 2 p.m.

The Timberwolves trailed by just one point at 70-69 with 2:47 left in the second half, but Treasure Valley’s Dajon Howe made a layup just over a minute later to stay ahead down the stretch as Treasure Valley handed Blue Mountain

a 75-71 NWAC defeat on Wednesday.

Howe and teammate Joseph Lupumba combined for three more points at the line in the final 30 seconds to keep the Chukars out front.

Didi Seme led Blue Mountain (4-19, 0-9 NWAC) with 17 points. Craig Mueller added 13, and Shaw Broncheau 11. Howe led the Chukars with 17 points and a 6-of-6 performance at the line. DeVaughn Williams followed with 16 points.

The Timberwolves host Columbia Basin on Saturday at 4 p.m.
