NOTICE OF BUDGET COMMITTEE MEETING

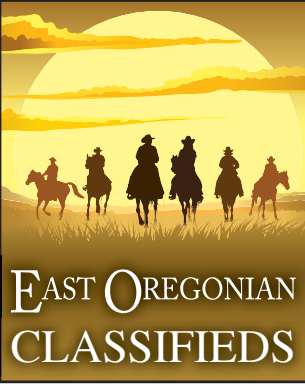
