SENTENCES

PENDLETON — The following sentences have been imposed in Umatilla County courts:

FELONY

•Jovanni Lemus, 21, Hermiston, pleaded guilty to Attempt to Commit Class B Felony: sentenced to 3 years probation, 180 sanction units, 90 maximum jail units and 80 hours community service.
