- tus and equipment. Acquire real property and
- make additions to, furnish, equip and renovate existing public safety facilities and pay bond issuance costs.

Bonds would mature in 21 years or less from the date of issuance and may be issued in one or more series. The tax rate is estimated to be \$0.23 per \$1,000.00 of taxable assessed value. Actual rates may vary based upon interest rates incurred and changes in taxable assessed value. The estimate tax cost for the measure is an estimate only, based on the best information available from the county assessor at the time of the estimate.

As indicated in ORS 250.195. an elector may file a petition for review of ballot title in Umatilla County Circuit Court no later than 5:00 p.m. March 9, 2021.
