April 20, 1948 — April 13, 2021

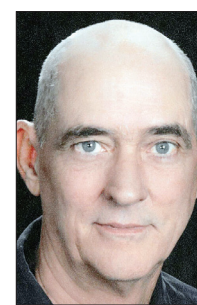

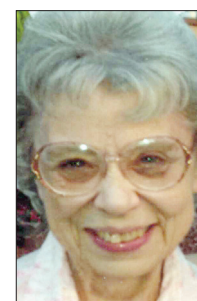
She was a very talented musician and taught piano lessons from her home.
