Frances was a loving wife and mother. She enjoyed taking care of her husband, reading the Bible, playing solitaire and crocheting.

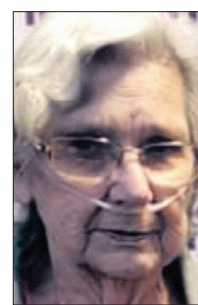
She was preceded in death by her father, Charles Evans; her mother, Irene McCrary; her sisters Cleta, Dorothy and Arlene; brother Donald;
