thrive today. Her work with Agape House was recognized by the President's Points of Light Foundation, the Oregon Human Development Corporation, and the Hermiston Chamber of Commerce.

Kathleen was a friend to many and beloved by her children, grandchildren and great-grandchildren. She was a talented cook, crafts woman, watercolor artist and pianist.

She was preceded in death by her parents, two brothers and two sisters.

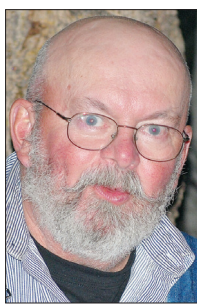
