BAKER CITY — This weekend features a special extra concert in the summer schedule for the Powder River Music Review.

Barefoot & Bonafide takes the Powder River Pavilion stage in Geiser-Pollman Park at 6 p.m. Saturday, July 31.

Brass Fire headlines the Sunday concert, starting at 4 p.m., Sunday, Aug. 1.

Admission is free to the concerts. Donations are welcomed to support the music series, which relies on grants, sponsorships and community donations.

area. The band most recently performed in the park on July 17 as part of Miners Jubilee.

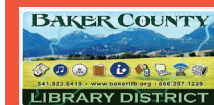
Brass Fire formed about eight years ago, and members are all current or retired music instructors.
