His animals work about 25 rodeos a year. They recently worked St. Paul with Korkow Rodeos and Corey & Lange, who also will be at Hermiston.

"We work together at a lot of rodeos," Bridwell said. "We have a really good, healthy working relationship. We all really like working together and we work together really well. If everyone does their job, it makes it a lot easier."

Among the stock Bridwell will be bringing to the Farm-City Pro Rodeo are bareback horses Girl Crush, who has made four trips to the National Finals Rodeo, Ted (3 NFRs), Mary (3 NFRs), Meat Sweats (2 NFRs) and Scarlet Lady (1 NFR).

In the saddle bronc, Momma's Boy is a four-time NFR horse. He will be joined by Indian Burn (3 NFRs) and Beaver Bend (1 NFR).

One lucky bull rider will get a turn on four-time NFR bull Hou's Bad News. Other bulls in the lineup include Crowd Pleaser (1 NFR) and rising star Ghetto Spread.
