Skills include painting, plumbing, car-pentry, masonry, electrical, cus-todial work and maintaining sanitation standards in all facilities. Maintenance workers use hand and power tools to accomplish the work. Closes September 30, 2021

CRITPD-Police Officer Based in Hood River Oregon, the CRITFC Police Department provides 24-hour policing focused on the 150 mile stretch of the Columbia River from Bonneville to McNary Dams and adjacent lands by vehicle and boat. The department ensures adherence to all treaty fishing regulations, safety and emergency response, protection of archeological sites, and full police services to the 31 tribal fishing sites.

CRITPD-Dispatcher

Dispatchers are based in Hood River and are the communication link for all incoming calls to the police department. General business calls, calls for assistance, complaints, and general information for the public are answered and forwarded by the dispatcher. The position works rotating shifts to support the round the clock police services provided by the Columbia River Inter-Tribal Police Department.

All positions are permanent fulltime unless otherwise noted.
