Tribal Transportation Improvement Plan 2022-2026
- The CTUIR Public Works Department and the Tribal Planning Office are performing the first update to the Transportation Improvement Plan since 2017. This plan is designed to guide the proposed improvements to the transportation network on the Umatilla Indian Reservation for the next 3-5 years, but can be amended as often as annually to incorporate changing community needs. Adoption of this plan will enable the CTUIR to use BIA-allocated transportation planning, construction and maintenance funds during the years of 2022 through 2026. The Public Works Department will present proposed transportation improvements to the Land Protection and Planning Commission for review and invites the public to provide testimony virtually at the meeting. The meeting will be held on Tuesday, October 12, 2021 at 9:00 a.m. Due to COVID-19 precautions, this meeting will be held via Microsoft Teams. 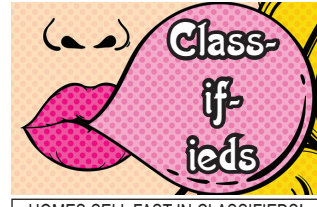
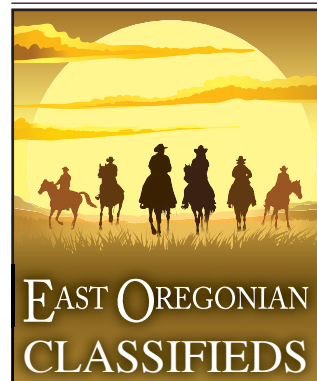
