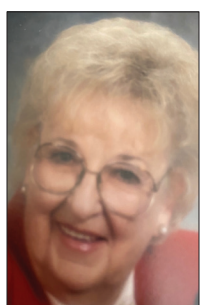


OBITUARIES

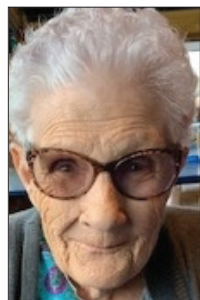

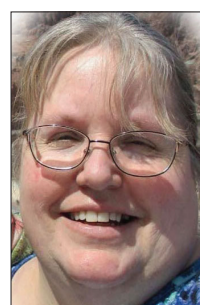
