Eliot Treichel will lead a workshop titled "Short Story in a Month" through Fishtrap. Sessions will be held virtually on three Saturdays — Dec. 4, 11 and 18 — from 10 a.m.-noon.

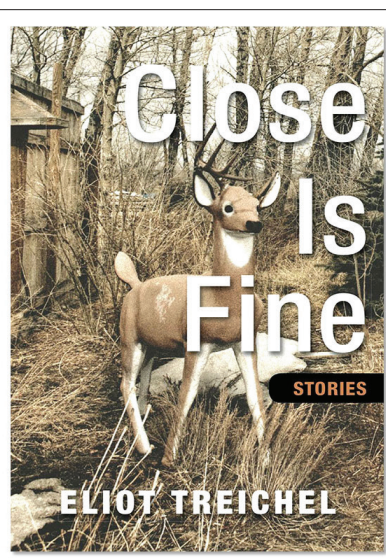
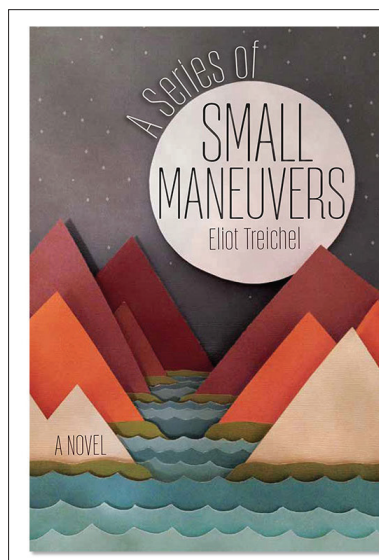
Registration is \$180, or \$165 for Fishtrappers. To register, go to www.fishtrap.org/workshop-treichel/.

Treichel will ask: What are the essentials of a short story? How do you write one?

In the multi-part workshop, participants will explore these questions with the goal of writing a short story in a month. Each workshop session will

begin with a short lecture about a specific aspect of story craft and then a generative writing exercise related to that craft issue, with plenty of time for questions and answers.

As the month progresses and the stories take shape, participants will receive feedback and collaborative advice. The final workshop will focus on editing and revision.
