NATIVE AMERICAN BEADING WITH ROGER AMERMAN

This two-day workshop is set for Feb. 26 from 10 a.m.-4 p.m. and Feb. 27 from 9 a.m.-1 p.m. Cost is \$150.

Workshop participants will learn the basics of beading with seed beads, sizes 10/0 and 11/0, as well as a two-needle process in order to construct a beaded neck bag. This method

of bead stitching is referred to as "contour" and "lane" bead stitching.

Roger Amerman is an enrolled citizen of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma, a former park ranger with the U.S. National Park Service (Whitman Mission National Historic Site, Walla Walla), as well as a highly accomplished artist who competes and has been featured throughout the United States.

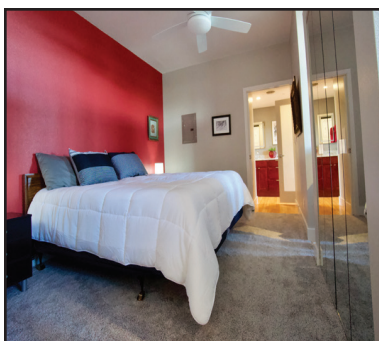
