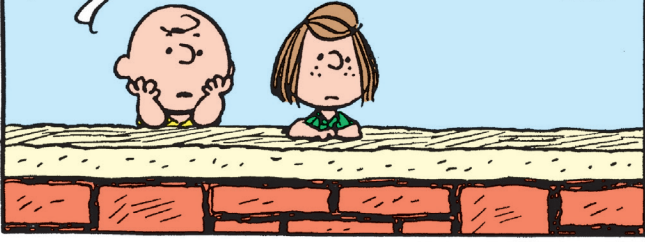

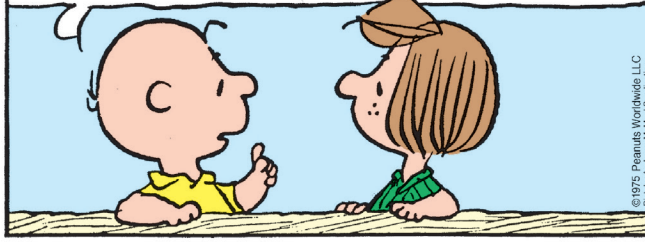
CLASSIC PEANUTS

YEARS LATER, HE REALIZED THAT HIS GRANDMOTHER WAS SMARTER THAN HE THOUGHT SHE WAS...



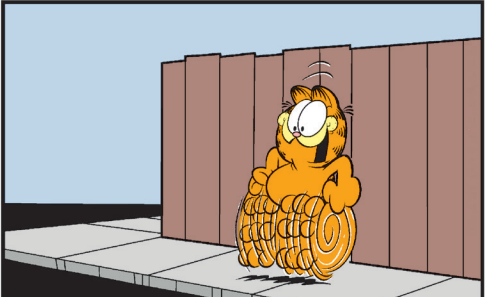
