Ladd Marsh Bird Festival is May 13-15

A GRANDE — May is going to the birds again this year with the full return of the Ladd Marsh Bird Festival set for May 13-15.

After no festival in 2020 and a scaled-back version in 2021, this year will be more like previous events, said Steve Clements.

Clements is on the board for Friends of Ladd Marsh, the nonprofit volunteer organization that took over the festival after the retirement of biologist Cathy Nowak.
