

Inaugural Arts Festival coming to EOU

LA GRANDE — Art is taking over Eastern Oregon University for the first-ever Arts Festival, organized by the College of Arts, Humanities and Social Sciences on May 20 and 21.

“The main goal of the event is to have a day celebrating the arts and highlighting locals making great art and food in our community,” said Heather Tomlinson, EOU theatre professor.

In addition to two days of art and music events, the festival coincides with “Rent,” the first musical in two years presented at EOU May 19-22.
