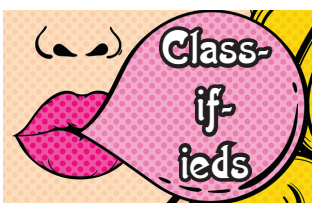

A-TSP-22-001: City of Boardman, Morrow County, and the Oregon Department of Transportation: holders of right-of-way. Port of Morrow: Applicant. The subject property is described as the Port of Morrow Interchange and the intersection to the north with Columbia Avenue.
