

BAKER CITY — Chicagobased band Marbin first released an album in 2009 and now, multiple albums and tours later, they are coming to East-

Marbin plays instrumental jazz fusion.

"A lot of improvisation — a combination of jazz and rock," Rabin said. "It's a rockin' show."

Band members are Rabin, Danny Markovitch (saxophone), Everette Benton Jr. (drums) and Jon Nadel (bass).

Marbin used to tour 200 to 250 days every year.

"What's typical these days?" Rabin said, referencing the return of live shows after the pandemic.

And the price of gas also affects bands like Marbin that drive to all the shows.

Their last tour was in Florida, and they played with the band Yes on a rock cruise.

"That was a lot of fun," Rabin said.

This tour brings Marbin to the Pacific Northwest — a route they cover about once every two years.

"We're playing a lot of small towns," he said. "This is your only chance for awhile."

Marbin plays all original music.

"We have a good time — we write the music that comes from our imagination," Rabin said.

And music, he said, is special.

"There's a certain power to it — the power of the arts, it changes you," he said.
