JOSEPH — Classic cars of all varieties are rolling into town this week for the 36th Wallowa Mountain Cruise.

"There will be well over 100 vintage cars," said organizer Jude Graham.

Although there isn't a public event on Friday, she said visitors will see these shiny cars all over town.

Then, on Saturday, Main Street shuts down as the cars line the road for the show-n-shine from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. Graham said the day is full of people strolling the street and exploring the town.

"We get a ton of visitors," she said.

Food vendors will be set up during the day, and two musical groups — Good Question and Dave Staigle — will set up at opposite ends of the street to play starting at 11 a.m.
