to seek their fortunes "in the tand of Ophir." I'm not jesting. Seven hundren women have already engag. od passage, and the remaining three hundred are expected to be forthcoming in good time, for ulthough the steamer was to have loft yesterday, I don't think sho will depart for a week yet. All these one lhousand ladies will want husbands; so look out for the syrens. They are partaere
less, and they will each aave a pair of less, and they will each bave a pair of
sheep's eycs to throw at the wireless. sheep's eycs to throw at the wifeless.
The price of passage out, to common folks, is two bundred dollars on board the Continental, but these spinsters and widows (tor the fair emigrees belong to both classer) are only charged twenty-five dollars each, and find their uwn bedding. Those who are eligible and worthy, (are good-looking and industrious,) but have no money, are talsen out on credit, giv. ing bonds to pay as soon as they earn
suffieient. All are guaranteed four Bufficient. All are guaranteed four dollars a week wages, paid in gold, when they arrive out, but at what
species of labor 1 cannot discover. They have only Mr. Mercer's cbaracter and word for it that they will not be left to starve if they do not submit, in that distunt region, to earn a subsistence by debauchery. I went on board the steamer on Saturday and saw the crowd of women; most of them are from sixteen to twenty years of age, though some, especially
the widows, run up to twenty-five or the widows, run up to twenty-five or thirty. The majority are from Bos-
ton, Lowell, and other Eastorn towns, ton, Lowell, and other Eastorn towns, and rumor says not a few of them leavo inodorous names behind them. Ot those from this city, 1 understand that several have been of indifferent oharacter, and the Magdalen Society is trying to ship off a number of reformed nymphs du pave us models of purity and perfection. I trust they will prove worthy of their new char-
aeters when they get to their destina. aeters when they get to their destination. But such a Tower of Babel as this steamer is, with all these women on board I Such a confusion of tongues ! And such coquetthinga the men will hang round the ship to pee the curiosities, and the ship to reo shoid kissing their hands girls can't avoid kissing their hands and otherwise displaying their affec and otherwise displaying their affectionate natures. Indeed I was eyewith ness to two or three lose-passages on board, which took place when the performers fancied no one was looking; for human nature is buman nature, ail the world over. Somehow, I pity sand Milliners. Wanted ends comicaliy. How will this one end? Somehow, I think the steamer will never arrive out. A bad season of the year is ap proaching. Thestrait of Magellen is a dangerous place. Will the vessel go through in safety? Or will she tounder with ber luad ot humanity and fill the sea with mairmaids hereafter in that direction? That's the question. Some of these fair advena turers are very pretty. Some are realIy quite handsome- None of them are decidediy piaia. have charming figures, scft, voices, and gentle, winning, manners. It they ever get over to your side of the continent, take my word for it, there will be an excitement among the mas. culines.
