

A NEW METHOD OF PULVERIZING ORES.

The Monitor (Alpine county) Gazette gives the following description of some machinery for a quartz mill with a capacity to pulverize 25 tons daily.

The machinery consists first of a crusher, weighing complete with shaft and pulley one ton. With fifteen horse power, making 1,023 revolutions per minute.

The reduction is not done by rubbing or grinding, but by blows given by the paddle-wheel, by the attrition of the particles one against another, and by the action of the vortices of air created within the cylinder by the rapid motion of the paddles.

The machinery is on the ground, and the Boston Company are about to put it up: The machinery consists first of a crusher, weighing complete with shaft and pulley one ton. With fifteen horse power, making 1,023 revolutions per minute. One of these machines will crush gravel size fifteen tons of ordinary quartz per hour—requiring one man to attend the crusher and two to handle the ore.
