FRENCH OPINION OF PRESIDENT JOHNson .- The Paris Constitutionel writes In favor of President Johnson's policy of conciliation. Noticing his speech to the southern delegates, it says :

After a discourse as conciliatory as pacific, the hour of unreserved clemency has srrived, and under penalty of a regretable contradiction, the sympathetic words of the President cannot fail to translate themselves in acts. This will be, without doubt, a most happy surprise; but America is an astonishing nation, where the most profound transformations take place as if by enchantment. In a single day this eminently practical people is stricken with madness and precipitates itself into all the horrors of a civil war; the strife ceases, and insteed of all the excesses of a reaction it disbands its armics, reassumes again its peaceful occupations, and begins talking all of a sudden the language of reasonable people. Its statesmen check themselves in their road to useless vengeance, and know how to employ, in their self sacrifice, the generous words, which, far better than mere force, disarm their enemies and appease their hatred.


