## THE TRIA $\triangle$ OF JEFF. DAVLS.

The N. Y. Herald, of Nov. 1st, on information received from Washing ton, bays that Jeff. Davis is to bo ar raigned on the charge of treason in lerythe plan of prosecution will embrac no otaer charge. All charges of com. plicity with Wirtz, ete, are to be aban doned, and the purpose of the prose treason and fix its punishment. As the Wirtz trial was intended to reveal the inhumanities of the rebel leaders and forever disgrace the rebel Confederacy in the eyes of the world, the trial of Davis is intended to make equally odious the treason which had bred such horrors. It is well known that Mr. Davis claims that be eannot be tried for treason, on the ground that bound to follow her lead. His entire defence would rest on the basis of the right of Secession. Sach a plea would have but little force, in view of the vention of Mississippi, the State which Davis sepresents, nullified instead of repealing the Act of Secession, thus doclaring that the State did not secede, and agreeing with one of the great principles which Eresidont Johnson adopted and persistently maintained, that none of tho Southern States were ever legally out of the Union. It was also determined that the Wiriz trial should be the last trial by Court Martial. The trial of Davis will bo before the highest tribunal in the land. It is not known as yet whether Chief Justice Cbase will preside, but it is presumed that he will. At a Cabinet session in August, when the datails were arranged, it was dececided that the trial of Wirz, but the long deluys in that case may tend to delay that of Davis. The Attorney-General was authorize to select three counsel to aid him in tho prosecution. Mr. Speed is a native of the South, and it wus decided that another Souhern and two Northern lawyers should be retained. It was sug. gested that it was desirablo chat the army should also be represented. The following attorneys were finally selected as the prosecutiog counsel: Hon. James Speed, Attorner General of the United States, Hon. John H Clifford, formerly attorney General of Mass achusetts, Major General Lowell H. Roussean, member of Congress clect from Kentucky; Wm. H Evarta, of New York City. It has been understood for several months past that Mr . Davis bad selected his counsel, or bad accepted the services of the following geutlemen: Charles O'Conor, of New York City; Ransom H. Gillett, of Al bany. It is probable that the prisoner will himselt supervise, if he does not conduct bis defenso.
