More Cave Dibcoveries of Human Ikmains in England.-The dibcovery of foesit human remains in a eave in the Ryhopo colliery, in England, have already been announced, but the London Times gives the following additonal particulars:

it has not yet been fally explored, or its termination reached, it is likely that still more will be found as the quarrymen go on with their work. Among the bones dug up on Thurday lasit, are two adalt human skulls, male and female, the lower jaw-bone of a child of five or six years old, and a number of other bones, almost enough to construct another skeleton. The dimensions of the sdult skulls are as follows: Circumfurence of both, 218 inches; across the posterior lobe, 6

The most probable conjecture now is, that these relice are those of a family of thieves or robbers, or of refugees from inrasion or persecution, and that they had met their death suddenly and unexpectediy-perhrpe by suffocation, like the Macdonala of the Isle of Eigg, as the hands of the chief of Macleod, or the Arabs in the cave of Dabra, at the bands of those of Gen.
