Obgoon State Treaeury．－We are under obligations to his Excellency the Governor of Oregon for a copy of an exhibit of the State Treasury from the 10th of September，1864，to the 28th of February，1866，incluaive of both dates．From which we learn that the balances then on band with the recelpts up to date in the State Treasury amount to $\$ 206,28062$ ，of which there has been paid on war－ rante，8197，141 61，leaving a balance in the Treasury on the 28 th of Febru－ ary， 1856 ，of $\$ 99,13902$ ，of which 869 ， 79669 is General Fund，and the re－ mainder the aggregate of the Mili tary，Penitentiary，University，Es． cheat and School Funds．
There are still due the State Treasn ury in addition to the above，an ag． gregate of $\$ 11,75642$ ，for taxes from Lane，Douglas and Josephine counties for the year 186$\}$ ，and an aggregate of $\$ 33,45403$ for taxes from Baker， Curry，Coos，Grant，Jackaon，Jose＊ phine，Union and Umatilla counties for the year 1865，making a total of taxes still due the State of $\$ 45,11045$ ．
