Epitome of Telegraphic News.

COMPILED FROM THE OREGONIAN.

DATES TO APRIL 1.

Chicago, March 26.—The Senate yesterday was occupied until nearly 6 o'clock, P. M., on the Stockton case, the discussion ending in the passage of a resolution by yeas 22, nays 21, declaring him not entitled to a seat as Senator from New Jersey, whereupon Stockton vacated. The President's veto message was then read, having been previously circulated from hand to hand among the Senators and Representatives who crowded the floor.

The Senate now consists of forty-nine members; of whom thirty-one are counted in favor of passing the bill over the veto, and 15 against; three—Dixon, Foote and Wright absent—sick. An attempt will be made today, with every prospect of success.

The Secretary of War laid before Congress an important report of General Pope on the condition and necessities of his Military Department. He says the protection of travelers crossing the plains is a question of absorbing interest, and argues to show the necessity for the speedy completion of the Pacific Railroad which will do more than any other single cause to overcome and prevent Indian difficulties.

Gen. Pope then enters into a long discussion of the various routes to Montana via Colorado, New Mexico, etc., and proposes that the Government should restrict itself to one route for furthering that route. He says the present Indian management is growing worse daily, and submits an estimate of the number of troops that will be required to preserve order. He specifies fifty-seven points at each of which there should be a small garrison. The aggregate is twelve regiments of infantry of six thousand effective men and six regiments of cavalry, of three thousand efficient men, and that one-third more of each arm of the service should be added for contingencies.

Washington, March 28.—Senator Foote, of Vermont, Senator since 1851, died at four o'clock this morning. The Senate, as a mark of respect, adjourned immediately after the reading of the journal.

New York, March 28.—The following is the tone of the morning papers on the veto:

The Herald says that the veto exhibits this bill as the most flagrant device for overturning the reserved rights of the States in their legislative and judicial tribunals ever attempted in Congress. It appears to be a thousand times more objectionable than the freedmen's bill and the veto marks the impassable barrier between the President and the ruling radicals of Congress.

The Tribune says: Let us not think that he vetoes the bill he might have phrased differently, but he chooses to let us know that not this particular bill, but any measure whereby Congress shall attempt to protect the blacks against white abuse, must encounter this determined deathly opposition.

The Times says the logic of the veto is so keen and searching, and so characteristic, that we are of the opinion that the strongest advocates of the measures will see how very important it is that the veto power should exist.

The World says the veto is conclusive that the conflict between the President and Congress admits of no compromise.

Albany, Oregon, April 1.—Thomas Smith, whose trial was had yesterday for the murder of his brother and of his brother's wife, terminated about eleven o'clock last night. The jury brought in a verdict of guilty, being out less than twenty minutes. He is sentenced to be hanged on the 10th of May next.

In the District Court at Vancouver during the last week, three divorces were granted; it seems that Vancouver is a good place for divorcing as well as marrying. In the same Court Timothy Martin was sentenced to one year in the penitentiary on the charge of grand larceny.
