We pablish this morning a letter addressed to Mr. C. S. Miller, of this city, from Mr. Morehead, Seoretary of the Grant County Protective Association, which deserves the serions consideration of every business man in this town. As stated by us heretofore, the people of Grant County have or ganized this association for self prow tection from the marauding bands of Indians that infest the John Day country, and who bave thus far retarded the development of ite mineral wealth. The Association bas adopted a Conatitution, the preamble of which sets forth that " the depredations of the In. dians are daily becoming bolder, threatening to interrupt and eventa ally destroy our cummunication with the Dalles, thus causing an advance in the price of all the necessaries of life, besides placing the lives and prop. erty of our citizens in great danger" The preamble further says that "the protection attempted to be given to our settlers by the Government is entirely inadequate, serving rather to ensourage than deter Indian hostilities." Every man living in the Dalles knows that the facts set forth in the extracts above quoted are substan tially true, and without the least shadow of coloring. The people of this section have suffered to the amount of thousands of dollars in prop. erts, as well as in the loss of trade with the Jobn Day country, and all of this owing to a band of miserable Indians who infest that region. The Government expeditions that have at tempted to rid us of these savages bave every one signally failed to accomplish anything, owing to the commanders in the field, us well as at beadquarters, being incompetent to the task.
It is now proposed to adopt another plan-and to our idea the best oneof raising sufficient money to pay as rewards for sealps to those who will undertake the work of wiping out these eavages. To aecomplish this it is necessary that every man in this community interest himself in the matter, and give in proportion to his means to the funds of the nesociation. Grant County will contribute two thoasand dollars, and we of the Dallos who are equally interested ought to be able to raise an equal amonnt With this sum a good party can be put in the field who wilt do service equivalent to ten times the amount in a short space of time. Let the people be careful in solecting this party, and particularly the man who is to lead them. They should be experienced Indian fighiers, who can travel without the incumbrance of baggage, ex cept the aetual neéessaries of camp life; men who will diaregard the clamors of the very Christian editors and others who are always shocked
at the killing of an Indian, buc who are never effeoted at the wholesale murders and robberies that are per petrated almost daily on our people. Let the motto of the party be "Death to all redakins," and they will find in the end that it is the only true policy.
To Be Rearoved, - We see it atated that acting Governor Mengher, of Montana, has commenced removing all Territorial officers who oppose the President,-Revicio.

If you said that Gov. Meagher is removing ail Union mes from office, and appointing ex rebels, it would be nearer right.

We are informed by Mr. Robb, Wells, Fargo \& Co.'s messenger, that three men were drowned in Snake river, near the moath of Tueanon river, a few days since, while attempt. ing to cross that stream.
The District Court of San Fran. cisco has issued an injunction restrain. ing Chief Burke from executing the order of the Supervisors, to destroy all the nitroglycerine in the city.
