IEASTERN NEWS.
Washington, May 21 - The whiskey and tobaceo interesta aro represented almost daify before the Waye and Means Cotimittee. The delegates re presenting the whiskey distillers ure urging the reduction of the tax to orie dollar per gallon on distilled spirits. They claim that the manufactur ers and Government would be largely benefited.
Washington.May 22-In the Senate Mr. Williams, of Oregon, introduced a bfll granting lands to nid the construction of a railroad and telegraph from Salt Lake to the Columbin river. Tbe bill opening the prablic ands of Alabama, Misissippi, Arkansas and Florida to settlement under the Homestead
laws, without regard to color, and extaws, withoat regard to color, and ex take the osth of allegiance, was debat ed and passed. Mr. Sherman spoke for two bours in advocating the bill for consolidating the national debt.

The House passed the Bankruptcy bill reported last Thureday-the bil reported by a select commitue and which differs from the former billonly in some slight particulars-yeas, 69, nays, 57.
The House had an elaborate debate on the tobacco tax, and agreed on the following rates: On cavendieh plag and twist, 60 cents per pound; on fine 40 cents ; cigars 84 per thousand, and 40 per cent. ad valorem; provided the first ten dollars valuation be not absted.
Washington, May 23.-The Senate ook up the reconstraction question. Mr. Sumner of Mass., urged delay, deelaring the country had gained much by postponement already. Mr. Fessenden, of Maine, and Mir. Conness ot Californis, opposed postponement. Mr. Howard, of Michigan, opened the debate, speaking two hours in defense of the plan as reported by the commit. ee. Several amendments were offer ed, and ordered printed.
Washington, May 23.-Dr. George Cooper, post surgeon at Fortress Monroe, reports the result of the medical examination of Jeff. Davie, made in compliance with the instructions of the President. He says, Davis is considerably emaciated and bis nervous system greatly deranged. Want of sleep has been the great and almost the principal cause of his nervons excitement. This is produced by the tramp of sentinels, and the guard relief almost invariably awakes him. He has scarcely enjoyed two hours of unbroken sleep since his confinement. Precautions have been taken by the surgeon by placing matting along the sentry walks to alleviate this source of disturbance but only with partial success.
