Washington, May 29.-The Senafe by unanmious vote of 43 ayes, struck out the Bd section of the constitationwhamendment, when Howard offered a substitute as agreed to in caucus, as follows : No person sball be a Sehator or Repreeentative in Congrees, or elect or for President and Vice President, or hold any office, civil or military, under the United States, or underany state, who baving previously taken in oath as member of any State Leg. slature, or an executive or judicia officer of any State, to tupport the Constitution of the United States, sball bave engaged in insurrection or rebellion agaiust the same, or given aid and comfort to the enemies thereof; but Congress may, by vote of two. thirds of each thouse, remove such dis ability. Howard also proposed an amendment to the first section by sub stituting the words, "born in the United States and subject to the juris' diction thereof, are eitizen United States aud of the State where amend the second section so as to to portion representation according to portion representation accordiag to the firet notice the minority bed re ceived of the result of the caucus reld by the majority He theretore moved that the amendment be printed and that the subject be postponed till to that the subject bo postpo ind 10 morrow. On motion of Mr. Fessen den, tois order was entered. Mr Sumner substituted a bill for the enabling act wird provides that when any State lately in rebellion shall have ratided the foregoing amendment, and shall havo modied and laws in conformity therewith, and shall have further provided tha there shan bo no donial orthe elective franchise to eitizens of the United States because of race and color, and that all persoos sball be equal bofore the law, the Senators and Represent atives from such states as are found daly elected and qualified may, after having taken the required outh of of fice, be admitted into Congress as sucb provided, that nothing in this section shall be so construed us to require the disfranchisement of the mau who is now allowel to vote.
