Maximilian＇s European Home．－A writer in Blackwood＇s Majazine thus describes Maximilian＇s home in the Adriatio：
＂On a grand bold bluff over the Adriatio stands one of the most pio－ uresque chateaux I ever beheld，al－ most covering the plateau，bave where a little space is stolen frum the pro－ jecting arm of the building for a fow： er knot or a fountain．It displays all that can be accomplished by irreguiar outline and varied color．Towergand minaret and buttress，projecting win． dow and deep shadowing cornice，with ornamented architrave and stained glass，have done their very best，and made one the most delightful houses to live in，and one of the bandsomest to look at，in Europe．Splendid gardens lie to the rear backed by a noble foreat， stretching away to the foot of a monn： tain．
This elegant establishment was built by Maximilian，who lavished up－ on it all the resources which wealth and refined taste could command to make it an earthly paradise；yet he bas left this sceno of peaceful enjoy． ment for the cares and dangers of im perial life among a hostile people．It is only an other iliustration of the rest essness of man，and the folly of pre erring shadow to substanee and emp ty honor to aubstantial comfort：＂
Beautify your Homes：－Nothing 30 unerringly shows a man＇s charac－ ter and tastes，as his house and ite surroundings，when they come under bis direct superviaion．The man who builds an ungainly house and pays no attention to its outside appearance，or internel arrangements is of a collree， uncultivated nature；while he who dis． plays taste in these matters，has at least shown refinement，and the prob， ability is，that bis whole nature is of similar texture：Every one who bas a home of his own shonld pride bim self on its appearance．If it＇s nothin buta shanty，cleanliness and the exer cise of a little taste will have wonder ful effect in removing anything pulsive trom it and a very liting re－ pastily bestowed in cultivatio a for rasily beal wed andivaling a fev der it absolutely attractives，will ren deritary solutely attractive．A cotem porary says，＂The planting of fruit trees and vines is a cheap operation and every one should plant his yard with some one or other of the beauti－ ful varieties of the trees of our wood before it is too late．How beautifu does a well shaded homestead luok compared with the hot，dusty，naked premises of the ide and lazy．Plan trees，plant vines，cover your jards with the shade of the peach，plam and grape vine，and save in comfort and pooket thereby．
