## NEW HATCHERY SITE IS FOUND

STATE FISH WARDEN ASKED TO LOOK OVER POOL AT HEAD-WATERS OF FALL RIVER—NEED FOR CHANGE CITED.

What is thought to be the site of one of the finest natural fish hatcheries in the United States has been found within 20 miles of Bend and efforts are being made to interest the state fish warden in moving the present hatchery to the new location. The site is located at the source of Fall River where lies half a mile of smooth water which remains the same height the entire year, is of the proper temperature for brooding fish and has a level gravel bottom. According to authorities, no concrete pools or dams would need to be constructed, the only equipment necessary being screens. At the least calculation 5,000,000 steelheads could be hatched there annually.

In view of the fact that it will soon be necessary to move the present hatchery on the Deschutes river a

mile or so above the mills to a new site, the Fall River pond is of especial interest at this time. Efforts are being made to bring State Fish Warden R. A. Clanton here to look over the proposed ground.

It has been found that many fish are lost annually in the present pools due to the rising and lowering of the water and the excessive warmth of it. Because no road reaches the hatchery all cans of fish for planting in streams have to be carried out by hand. This has retarded the distribution to a large extent. The Fall River ground could be reached by a fine road which runs directly past the proposed hatchery.

As to expense, moving the fish to Fall River would involve only a small sum of money as no new pools would have to be constructed. Sportsmen are of the opinion that the fish should be moved this year on account of the large number being lost in the Deschutes river at present.

Two hatcherymen brought down three weeks ago from Bonneville looked at the Fall River site and pronounced it an ideal spot for the fish.

which the forestry service plans to drill on the dry range near Fort Rock resulted in the selection of two possible places.
