The action was unexpected, but Hart is so familiar with the advances of the animals that he went on with the actions outlined in the script and the camera caught the burro in the act of demonstrating its friendship, thus incidentally registering an unusual human touch for the production.

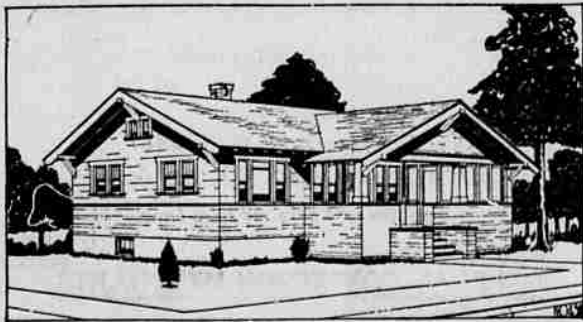

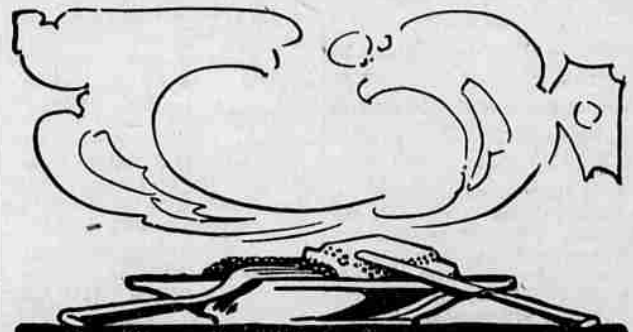
