**PLANS ARE MADE FOR AUTO TRIPS**

**SHRINERS ARE TO BE TAKEN TO FISHING HAUNTS OF CENTRAL OREGON COUNTIES AFTER THE CEREMONIAL.**

As a fitting entertainment to the Shriners who are to visit this city on Saturday, June 29, to attend the ceremonial to be held here, a schedule of one, two and three day trips has been provided by the committee, commencing with Sunday after the ceremonial is over and covering Monday and Tuesday, providing the guests desire to remain that long. Four such trips have been planned for Sunday, June 30, covering the one day; two trips have been planned for Sunday and Monday and one trip planned for Sunday, Monday and Tuesday, the guests to make their choice of the trips.

**One Day Trips for Sunday.**—Benham Falls, Spring river, upper Deschutes river points and logging camp lunch at I X L Lumber company. Altitude 4,220 feet; 20 miles and return. Metolius, altitude 3,182 feet. The Metolius river springs full grown from the base of Black butte and flows by the foot of Mt. Jefferson. One of Central Oregon's most wonderful streams. Forty-five miles and return. Suttle lake, altitude 3,430 feet. At the edge of the wonderful Cascade range, peopled with delicious trout, a mile and a half from Blue lake, a miniature crater lake seldom seen by visitors to Central Oregon. Forty-two miles and return. Crane Prairie, altitude 4,437 feet. A wonderful fishing ground, where the boys go to get the real big ones. Forty-three miles and return.

**Two-Day Trips for Sunday and Monday.**—Paulina and East lakes, altitude 6,000 feet. Central Oregon's most wonderful sight. These are

crater lakes possessing the deep blue of Crater lake itself, and filled with immense rainbow trout, many weighing 15 to 20 pounds. Don't take our word for it; come and see them. Forty-one miles and return. Crescent lake, altitude 5,010 feet; in the fastness of the Cascades, one of Oregon's most beautiful wonder spots. Jerry Hoyt of Portland will open his beautiful camp for the entertainment of the visitors. Seventy-one miles and return.

**BEND DENTIST LOSES LICENSE**

Manager of King Bee Dentists of This City Charged with Employing Unlicensed Men.

Dr. A. C. Froom, former manager of the King Bee dentists in this city, was deprived of his license to practice dentistry in the state at a meeting of the state board of dental examiners, held to consider charges against Froom and a Dr. E. M. North of Portland.

According to affidavits filed with the board, a woman patient treated by Froom went insane and afterward died as the result of the treatment. He was also accused of employing unlicensed dentists.

Froom opened the King Bee dentist parlors in this city in the fall of 1916 and continued them until about three weeks ago, when he was supposed to have closed up his business and left for Canada.
