The young woman is said to have taken the affair so much to heart that she found relief in the quiet waters that flow through the north country. The Doon is a river of Scotland in Ayrshire which, after a course of 30 miles, falls into the Firth of Clyde. It was on the banks of this stream, near "Alloway's auld haunted kirk," that the poet was born, and naturally he has made it the scene of many of his poems.

The tune to which Burns wrote the words of "Bonnie Doon," was an old Scottish air called "The Caledonian Heart's Delight," and an effort has been made to trace it to a still older Irish air.
