

NO NICKNAME YET FOR W. G. HARDING

Close Friends in Marion Have No Knowledge of Familiar Appellation For Republican Candidate.

MARION, Ohio, Aug. 30.—Despite the opportunity afforded by his middle name, Warren Gamaliel Harding has entirely escaped having a nickname, so far as anyone in Marion can discover.

Many years ago a few boy playmates called him "Doc" because his father was a doctor, but the nickname never stuck.

Harding's secretary, George B. Christian, Jr., calls the candidate "Gov." Harding was lieutenant governor of Ohio once. Harding refers to himself personally the "the candidate."

Mrs. Harding calls him "Warren," reporters address him as "Senator," and all visitors trying to be original greet him the "the next president."

BE CLOSELY WATCHED WEIGHT LIMITS WILL

Portland Manager Has Eye on Duffy Knorr—Howard Has Long String of Knockouts To His Credit.

Insistent that Duffy Knorr, who will meet Jimmie Lewis, of Los Angeles, in the curtain raiser at the Labor Day smoker here, must make 125 pounds, M. C. Hill, of Portland, who has Lewis as a member of his long string of fighters, has written Matchmaker E. C. Brick, stating that his own protegee will weigh in at 124 pounds or less. Lewis and Knorr are signed for six rounds.

Frankie Howard, clever 118 pound scrapper, who meets Kid Taylor, of Bend, in the 19 round main event, received his training in the Chicago ring, and has a formidable string of favorable newspaper clippings, a majority of which tell of knockout victories added to his credit. Taylor, who will also weigh in at 118 pounds, has proved a tough boy for imported scrappers to handle, but it is freely predicted that he will have the time of his young life when he swaps punches with the Chicago lad.

Greek George, of Bend, will fight at 120 pounds, against Nipper Davis, of Sacramento, a 122 pound scrapper. The bout will be for six rounds.
