SAD DAY COMING FOR BASEBALL PITCHERS

Example of Babe Ruth May Result In Production of Generation of Sluggers From Youthful Teams.

(United Press Staff Correspondent) NEW YORK, Oct. 21.—Beginning with the year 1930, professional baseball should have a batting renaissance.

At just about that time the unintentional tutoring of Babe Ruth will begin to show its effect on the American youth. Kids now at the impressionable age will be beginning to break into box scores of professional baseball and the cards say that a flock of pitchers will begin to yell for a ball a trifle less lively. Owners of clubs, too, will favor legislation to keep a flock of pellets from leaving the grounds every day. Something new in the way of batting achievements will have to be invented, probably, because home runs should be as common then as ordinary hits are now.

The reason for this dip into prophecy naturally is that everywhere in the land the 10-year-old kid is imitating Babe Ruth. They've got his swing, his "stance" and even his "waggle."

Just as a caddy develops into a star, simply through conscious or unconscious imitation of the star drivers and putters he serves, so are the kids of today going to pick up some of Babe's home run methods.

Of course Babe is unusually adapted to heavy clouting, but it is generally admitted that his swing and "follow through" help a lot in gaining distance. No one is more apt in acquiring the cunning of a star than the 10-year-old boy.

Baseball players just starting their career should avoid becoming pitchers. In just a few more years the moundmen will be getting their bumps.

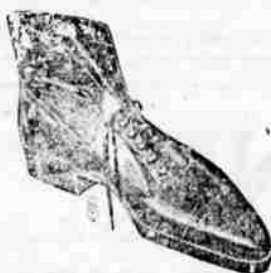
