SCIENTISTS SEEK AMAZON'S SECRETS

(By United Press to The Bend Bulletin)
PHILADELPHIA, Dec. 24. — A party of chemists and scientists, headed by Dr. H. H. Rusby, dean of the school of pharmacy at Columbia university, will sail shortly for a scientific exploration of the Amazon valley, in a quest for new plants and drugs of medical value. A government expert in entomology, an authority on ichthyology from the University of Indiana, and experts from other institutions will accompany the expedition, which is expected to last a year. New species of reptiles, fishes and insects will be sought by the party.
