Officers of the Oregon Newspaper conference, chosen at the session completed last week in Eugene, are as follows: Robert W. Sawyer, Bend Bulletin, president; Herbert J. Campbell, Portland Telegram, vice president; George Turnbull, University of Oregon school of Journalism, secretary; Eric W. Allen, University of Oregon school of Journalism, chairman of program committee.

The state newspaper conference meets annually in Eugene. Another important organization of newspaper men, the Oregon Editorial association, will hold its next session in Bend, it is generally understood, although the executive committee has not yet made a definite announcement on this point.

RECRUITING OFFICER GOES TO BREMERTON

R. C. Smith, In Year Spent In Bend, Establishes Record For Number of Enlistments.

R. C. Smith, formerly in charge of the U. S. navy recruiting station here, left last night to report for duty at the navy yard at Bremerton, where he will be assigned to a ship making a foreign cruise next summer.

He was accompanied by his wife and son, who will make their home at Bremerton until he receives his discharge from the service, after which they will return to Bend, where they will reside.

Mr. Smith was stationed here for over a year, establishing an excellent record for enlistments. The Bend station showed the greatest number of enlistments of any of the inland headquarters of the Northwest district. It was the last one in this classification to be closed.

Smith has bought a chicken ranch a mile south of Bend and will engage in the poultry business when he returns from the service.



Now we have twelve huge reservoirs called the Federal Reserve Banks, located at advantageous points and if there is an unusual drain upon one of these reservoirs there is a pipe line arrangement in the power of the Central Reserve Board that equalizes the strain and restores the level as before. In this manner several Federal Reserve Banks can render assistance to any other Federal Reserve Bank and they, in turn, to the small country banks.
