The extreme looseness of Japanese marriage bonds makes this process very easy, and it seems to be becoming popular, except possibly with the wives. A few days ago such a "Bluebeard" was arrested in Nagoya, just as he was collecting the premium on his fourth heavily insured wife.

**BUFFALO PROVES WANTON ASSASSIN**

**Geronimo, Aged Bull, Executed By Owner For Killing Valuable Domestic Cattle.**

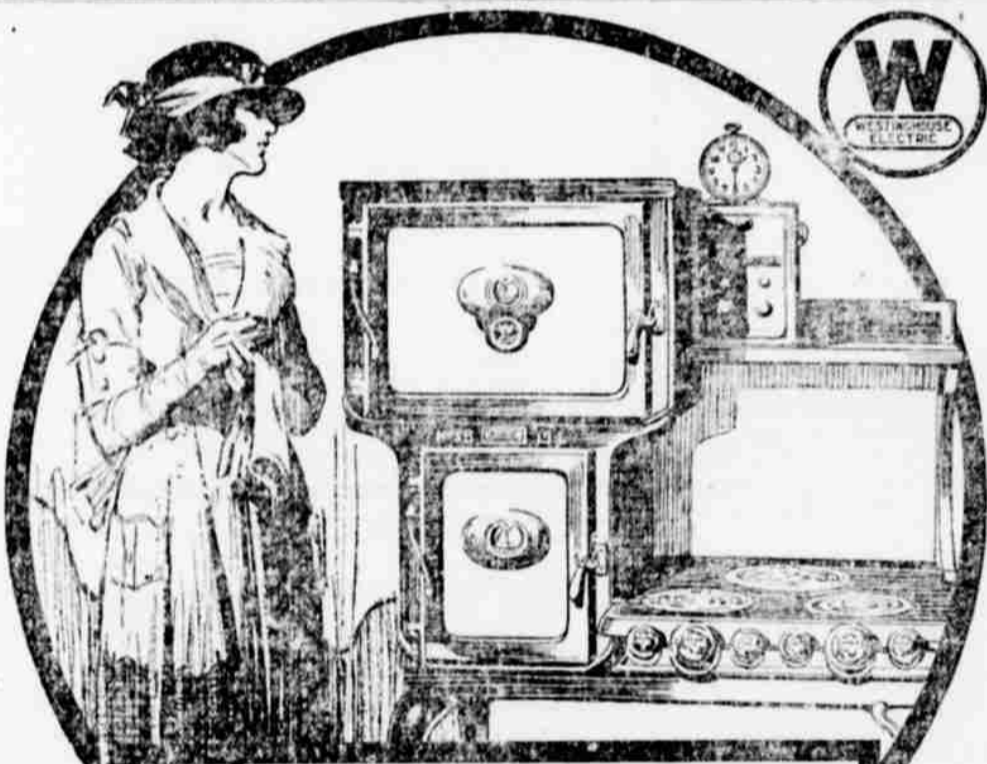
